## Aluwind Makes Castle Rock its First U.S. Location

### *Economic Development Council Attracts Company from Denmark*

CASTLE ROCK, Colo. (March 24, 2010) - Denmark-based Aluwind has chosen Castle Rock as its first location for expansion into the U.S. market with its aluminum wind-turbine components, the Castle Rock Economic Development Council announced today.

[Aluwind](#) is one of the world's leading manufacturers and suppliers of parts for the wind turbine industry, with a focus on the advantages provided by aluminum.

"Aluwind's choice to establish Castle Rock as such an integral component of its operations further connects Castle Rock to the New Energy Economy," said Castle Rock Economic Development President and CEO Frank Gray; "and we feel fortunate to have them as part of our business community."

With an eventual total of 80,000 square feet of industrial space in Castle Rock, Aluwind expects its 30 employees to begin providing customers with manufactured goods by July. Extended plans call for an increase of 50-75 workers, meaning the Castle Rock operations could quadruple in size within the next 18 months.

"We are excited about the prospects of establishing operations in Castle Rock, and we wish to thank the Town of Castle Rock and the Castle Rock Economic Development Council for helping to make it happen," said Jesper Flindt, Aluwind's VP.

Aluwind chose the Castle Rock location for its proximity to key partners in the wind turbine industry.

"The Castle Rock Economic Development Council will continue to recruit management teams who recognize the attractiveness of this location, with priorities on its convenience, its stability and its sense of community," said Wes King, chairman of the EDC.
